

Sweatshirt Layout

1. Decide which end of your fabric is going to be the top and mark it – put a safety pin at that end until all pieces are cut
2. If your material is in a circle cut on 1 fold – SEE ME FIRST before cutting
- ✱ 3. Once you cut out one sleeve use that as your pattern template for the second one
4. Once you cut out one of your hoods use that one as your pattern template for the second one
5. If both sides of your material are similar place a small piece of masking tape to the wrong side
6. Mark all pieces on the wrong side with what they are (Front, Back, Sleeve, Hood, Pocket)
7. USE SIZE B OR C FOR THE POCKET IF YOU WANT IT THE SAME SIZE AS THE SAMPLE HOODIES
8. Don't forget to lengthen or shorten your front, back and sleeves if need be
9. CUT ALL NOTCHES OUTWARDS!!!!
10. TEACHER CHECK WITH ME BEFORE CUTTING

This is how you should lay out your pattern pieces on your material

NOTE – YOU SHOULD START WITH EITHER THE FRONT AND BACK OR THE SLEEVES.

OTHERWISE WE DO NOT HAVE ENOUGH PATTERN PIECES FOR ALL STUDENTS
